At Sirv, we support young people who are involved in or at risk of becoming involved in the justice system. Our Youth Justice Behaviour Support offers a structured, relationship-based approach that builds insight, responsibility, and self-regulation — without shame or judgement.

We understand the complexity of behavioural and mental health needs in this space, and we work alongside families, youth justice workers, support teams and schools to create a new pathway forward.

#### Who We Support

- Young people aged 10–21 involved in the justice system
- Adolescents at risk of criminal offending or disengagement
- Youth under supervision, in residential care, or recently released
- Families, carers, and caseworkers seeking behavioural and emotional support

#### What's Included

- Individual Behaviour Support
  - Functional Behaviour Assessment & Behaviour Support Plan
  - Real-world goal setting: accountability, emotional regulation, motivation
  - Support with managing triggers, transitions, relationships & daily choices
- Youth Mentoring & Coaching
  - o Culturally responsive, relationship-first approach
  - Identity work, decision-making, confidence building, and purposefinding
- Family & Support Team Engagement
  - Coaching for carers, caseworkers or guardians
  - Collaborative planning with schools, resi-care or youth justice services
- School/Training Support
  - Advocacy and strategies to improve school engagement



o In-class coaching or coordination with VET and community programs

#### **Our Approach**

We believe that:

- Every young person deserves dignity, safety, and a fresh start
- Behaviour is communication especially when it's loud or withdrawn
- Real change happens through connection, not control
- Trust must be built before accountability can be expected
  Our model is practical, relational, and grounded in Attachment Theory,
  Positive Behaviour Support, and trauma-aware practice.
