We don't aim to "fix" behaviour — we work to understand it, and co-create practical strategies that support emotional regulation, communication, and connection.

What We Support

We work with children and teens aged 0–17 who may be experiencing:

- Aggression, meltdowns or self-injury
- Anxiety, school refusal or emotional shutdown
- ADHD, autism, or psychosocial disability
- Peer and sibling conflict
- Difficulty with transitions or routine
- Trauma or disrupted attachment
- Justice involvement or child protection
- Withdrawal, risk-taking or low motivation

What We Do

- Functional Behaviour Assessments (FBA)
Identify triggers, stressors and unmet needs behind behaviours
 - Positive Behaviour Support Plans (PBSPs)
Customised NDIS-registered plans that reduce behaviours of concern and build strengths
 - In-home and school-based support
Observe, coach and model strategies in real-life settings
 - Parent/carer coaching
Empower families with emotional coaching and behavioural tools
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- Youth mentoring and life coaching
Support for self-esteem, identity, routines and positive decision-making
